## **CAMP REMOTE USE POLICIES:**

- 1. PETS: No Pets are allowed at Camp Remote other than certified service animals.
- 2. SMOKING on the campground is discouraged and is only allowed in an area designated by the camp leader, director or person in charge. The smoking area needs to be one separate from the main campground with adequate depositories for the cigarettes to be extinguished with no risk of fire.
- 3. FIREARMS, weapons, explosives, or ammunition are not allowed on the campgrounds.
- 4. ALCOHOL & NON-PRESCRIPTION DRUGS, the use, sale, or possession of illegal drugs, look-alike or designer drugs, drug paraphernalia and alcoholic beverages, are prohibited on the campground.
- 5. FIREWORKS: This is forest land. Use of fireworks is prohibited.
- 6. CAMP QUIET HOURS: Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., noise will be kept to a reasonable level. Please be considerate of others.
- 7. THE BELL: use of the bell for calling groups together between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- 8. TELEPHONE: Cell service only or contact the onsite caretaker. (Contact list provided.)
- 9. INSURANCE: All groups must have adequate personal and liability insurance for all persons at camp. INSURANCE CO. \_\_\_\_\_POLICY NO.
- 10. CAMP STAFFING: Adequate numbers of counselors, responsible adults 18 or over should be provided.

## **CARE OF EQUIPMENT, FACILITIES AND GROUNDS:**

- 1. <u>CLEANLINESS</u>: Keep the grounds and buildings clean at all times. Follow the printed cleaning procedures for each area.
- 2. <u>DAMAGES</u>: Groups must pay for all damaged or lost property (beyond normal wear and tear).
- 3. <u>EQUIPMENT</u>: Any equipment moved from one area to another must be returned to the original site before departing camp; this includes beds, tables, chairs, carts, recreational equipment and hoses.
- 4. <u>KITCHEN</u>: Your cook, or kitchen supervisor, will be given an orientation with instructions for procedures and clean-up:
- a) No person under the age of 14 shall operate dishwasher.
- b) At least one adult must supervise youth under 18 in kitchen.
- c) Kitchen equipment and utensils are for camp use only; bring paper products for activities away from the campgrounds, and containers for taking left-overs home.
- d) A washer and dryer are provided for kitchen towels/rags only.
- 5. <u>ALL BUILDINGS</u>: Please turn off all lights, fans, equipment, etc. when not in use. Close all doors at night to keep critters out.
- 6. <u>CAMP FIRES</u>: Fires are ONLY allowed in the fire ring and with approval from Oregon Depart. of Forestry (541) 267-4136 or Coos County Depart. of Forestry: (541) 396-3121
